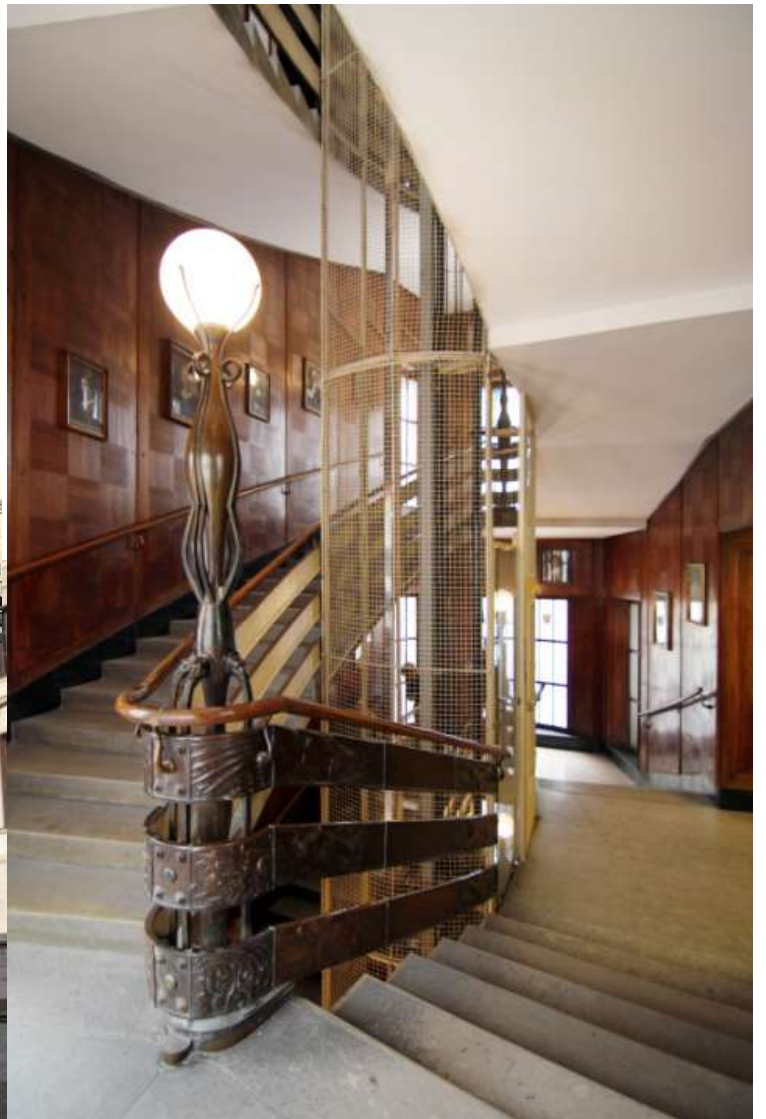

The timeless, humanistic architecture of Jože Plečnik in Ljubljana and Prague

Description

With the fall of the Austro-Hungarian Empire, many new countries emerged in Europe. Tendencies in new national architectural styles thus gained momentum that were in parallel with the trend of the domineering modernist style. This was the context in which, contrary to the trends of that time, the architect Jože Plečnik developed his own architectural language. He was mainly working in two Slavic capitals: Prague (where he was remodelling Hradčany, the Castle District, which has already been included in the UNESCO World Heritage List, and the Vinohrady suburbs) and Ljubljana. The urban concepts and architectural solutions in both cities were being developed in a parallel and comprehensive manner that had been going on since the 1920s. In both cities, urban planning, landscape and architectural changes were taking place. In Prague as well as in Ljubljana, the architect was facing an already existing urban

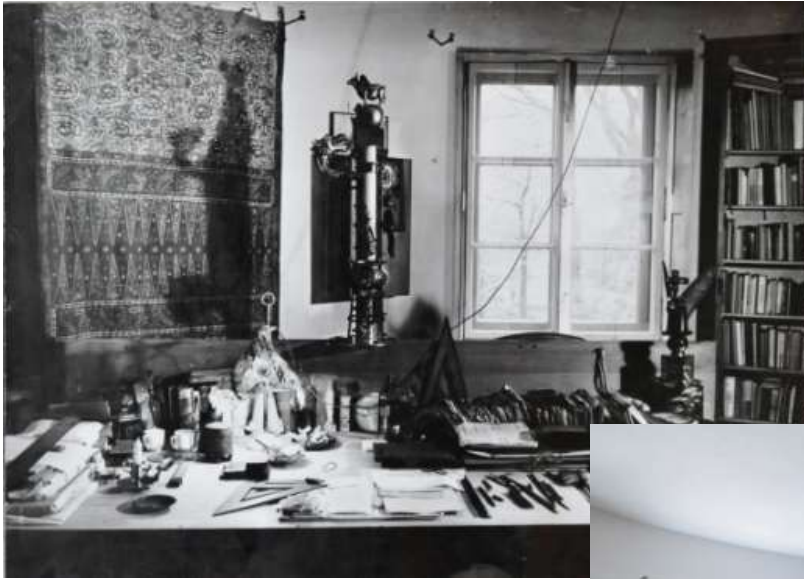
